APPLICATION AND ADMISSION PROCEDURE FOR BACHELOR'S AND TWO-YEAR DEGREES

1-THOSE WHO WILL STUDY WITH THEIR OWN MEANS

There is no education scholarship program offered by our University. Candidates who want to study at our University with a scholarship should apply directly to the institution that provides the scholarship.

Acceptation of foreign students wishing to study an associate degree or undergraduate degree at a Fculty or Collage in our University with their own means (without scholarship) are made according to Exam For Foreign Students For Higher Education in Türkiye (TR-YÖS) or Ege University Entrance Exam For International Students (EGEYOS) scores.

TR-YÖS is an exam for foreign students wishing to study with their own means at higher education instutions in Turkey to take and it is hold by Centre for Assessment, Selection and Placement (ÖSYM).

EGEYÖS is the exam which foreign nationals who want to study at Ege University to get a two-years or bachelor's degree have to take. This exam is carried out by the Rectorship of Ege University.

The results of TR-YÖS or EGEYÖS are valid **only** for students who want to get a twoyear or bachelor's degree. The students who already study at a higher education institution and want to be transferred to our university and students who want to pursue graduate studies need to apply to the relevant higher education institutions directly for their selection and placement process.

Conditions for Application

- a) Candidates of foreign nationality who are in the last year of their secondary education (high school) or those who have graduated from a high school
- b) Those who are Turkish citizens by birth but lost their Turkish citizenship by obtaining permission to renounce their Turkish citizenship from the Ministry of Interior, and those who certify that they have a blue card, which is given upon request to those who lost their Turkish citizenship. (In Article 7 of the Turkish Citizenship Law No. 5901, there is a provision that "(1) A child born in a marriage union with a Turkish citizen mother or father in Turkey or abroad is a Turkish citizen."
- c) Those with dual citizenship status who had foreign nationality at birth and have later gained T.C. (Turkish) nationality;
- d) Of Turkish citizens providing that certify that they have been country abroad where they received their high school education in years corresponding to high school education period
- Student candidates with Turkish nationality who continue their secondary school education abroad, the ones who completed the last 3 years of their secondary education (high school) abroad except KKTC (including those who completed all their secondary education (high school) abroad in schools that opened within the Turkish National Ministry of education except KKTC), before 01/02/2013;
- Student candidates who started their education abroad and completed their secondary education (high school) abroad except KKTC (including those who completed all their secondary education (high school) abroad in schools that opened within the Turkish National Ministry of education except KKTC.) after 01/02/2013;
- e) Those who have GCE AL examination scores with KKTC nationality, reside in KKTC and finished their secondary education (high school) in KKTC with those who have or will have GCE AL examination scores and enrolled and educated in colleges and high schools in other countries between 2005 and 2010 (on condition that they take the EGEYOS examination)
- f) Since it is a requirement to have received secondary school education by residing in the relevant country during secondary school education, those who graduated from the High

School with Open Education Abroad program affiliated to the Ministry of National Education by certifying that they had been in the relevant country in the years corresponding to their high school education

will be able to apply.

- a) Turkish nationals who completed all high school education in Turkey or TRNC,
- b) Those with KKTC nationality
- c) As defined "EGEYÖS Directive, article 9-1-subparagraph b", dual citizens who are Turkish citizen at birth (except those who provide the conditions in article 9-1 subparagraph d)
- d) Dual citizens, one of whose nationality is KKTC (except those who completed all their secondary education in KKTC high schools and have a GCE AL examination scores and those who have or will have GCE AL examination scores and enrolled and educated in colleges and high schools in other countries between 2005 and 2010),
- e) Those with Turkish nationality or dual citizens who are Turkish citizen at birth, as defined in "EGEYÖS Directive, article 9-1 subparagraph b", who attend schools within the Embassies in Turkey and foreign high schools located in Turkey

will not be accepted.

Things to do for Application

Application for TR-YÖS exam can be made over www.osym.gov.tr and application for EGEYÖS exam can be made over www.yos.ege.edu.tr.

Those with score 200 and higher marks from TR-YÖS or EGEYÖS should follow www.oidb.ege.edu.tr website to choose associate and undergraduate programs at our University.

Procedure for Establishment

Candidates who score 200 and higher marks from TR-YÖS or EGEYÖS in the relevant year can apply for foreign student quotas regarding associate and undergraduate programs.

Choosing programs can be made online through www.oidb.ege.edu.tr website. During the selection programs, the candidate log in the system with the candidate number and password (created during the application), fills the preference form and chooses the programs he/she will prefer.

Placements based upon a program are carried based on the national threshold of 20% within the framework of the quotas that are announced beforehand.

The scores of the candidates who made a choice in accordance with the Article 11-(2) of the Directive on the Principles of Admission of Foreign Students from Ege University; ranked from highest score to lowest score. Candidates who score higher marks in score ranking of the regarding program are placed according to quotas.

For the programs that can be preferred with a Language score in the YKS guide (English Language and Literature, American Culture and Literature, German Language and Literature, Translation and Interpretation programs and Tourism Guidance etc.), those who score 200 or more in TR-YÖS or EGEYÖS can apply. These candidates must also be successful in the Foreign Language Proficiency exam held by our University.

Candidates who gave preference to programs which are determined by OSYM that accept students with special aptitude tests (Physical Education and Sports School's and Turkish Music Conservatory's programs), must have 200 points or more from EGEYOS or TR-YOS in order to attend the special aptitude test. These candidates must follow the special aptitude test timetable of the corresponding school for the special aptitude test and apply for

the school in person.

Placement is made considering the Blended Scores for programs required special aptitude test, for other programs is made considering TR-YOS or EGEYOS scores. In case of equality in placement scores, placement procedure is done firstly according to the candidate's age, secondly preference order, then secondary school grade point average. Candidates are placed to only one program.

In the event that there is no application for the quotas in any program or the quotas are not filled, the quotas that are not filled and not applied are not transferred to the other program quotas.

For students who want to study by their own means at associate and undergraduate degree programs, NO OTHER EXAM RESULTS (such as Tawjihi, Al Shahada, GCE, Abitur, International Baccalaureat, etc., as well as SAT, ACT) excluding TR-YÖS or EGEYÖS will be accepted for placements at our University.

2-THOSE WHO WILL STUDY WITH FULL SCHOLARSHIP

Candidates who are placed in a department at our university with a scholarship do not need to apply to our university. These candidates can only start their education by registering on the dates and in the manner announced on the website www.oidb.ege.edu.tr.
