

## ***APPLICATION, ADMISSION AND REGISTRATION PROCEDURES (FOR BACHELOR'S AND ASSOCIATE DEGREE PROGRAMS)***

### ***1-SELF-FUNDED STUDENTS***

The admission of foreign students who want to study associate degree or undergraduate education at a faculty or college at our university with their own means (without a scholarship) is made according to the results of the Turkish International Student Admission Exam (TR-YÖS). (<https://tryos.osym.gov.tr/TryosYetki/Giris>). TR-YÖS is an exam held twice a year by the Student Selection and Placement Center (ÖSYM) and will be taken by students who will be accepted from abroad who want to study at higher education institutions in Türkiye with their own means. no other exam results such as tawjihi, al shahada, abitur, ib, sat, act will be accepted by our University. (Only for those who are citizens of TRNC, reside in TRNC, have completed their secondary education in TRNC and have a GCE AL exam result; candidates whose Mathematics result is A\* (140 Points), and at least two of their Turkish, Physics, Chemistry or Biology results are A (120 Points) can apply.)

For the transfer procedures (lateral transfer) of those studying at a higher education institution and the selection and placement procedures of those who want to study for postgraduate studies, candidates must apply directly to the relevant higher education institutions.

#### **- Conditions for Application**

1-Provided that they are in the final year of high school;

a) Applications of foreign nationals [those studying in secondary education institutions in Turkey (except for embassy schools, international private education institutions included in the Private International Schools Information System (MOBİS) and foreign nationals brought to our country within the framework of the project carried out by the Ministry of National Education (MEB)] provided that they have registered before the 2022-2023 academic year),

b) Applications of those who are Turkish citizens by birth but lost their Turkish citizenship by obtaining permission to renounce their Turkish citizenship from the Ministry of Interior, and those who certify that they have a blue card, which is given upon request to those who lost their Turkish citizenship. (In Article 7 of the Turkish Citizenship Law No. 5901, there is a provision that "(1) A child born in a marriage union with a Turkish citizen mother or father in Turkey or abroad is a Turkish citizen." (Those who are studying in secondary education institutions in Turkey, provided that they registered before the 2022-2023 academic year),

c) Applications of those with dual citizenship status who had foreign nationality at birth and have later gained T.C. (Turkish) nationality (Those who are studying in secondary education institutions in Turkey, provided that they registered before the 2022-2023 academic year),

d) Applications of those who are Turkish nationals and completed their entire secondary education in a foreign country other than TRNC (including those who completed their entire secondary education in Turkish schools opened by the Ministry of Education in a foreign country other than TRNC)

e) Applications of those who are citizens of TRNC, reside in TRNC, have completed their secondary education in TRNC and have General Certificate of Education Advanced Level (GCE AL) exam results,  
-Those who have or will have GCE AL exam results by enrolling and receiving education in colleges and high schools in other countries between 2005-2010  
-Citizens of TRNC who have completed their entire secondary education in a foreign country other than Türkiye and TRNC and have TR-YÖS results are accepted.

f) Since it is essential to be educated in the relevant country during secondary education, those who have graduated from the Open Education High School Overseas Program affiliated with the Ministry of National Education and who have been in the relevant country in the years corresponding to the secondary education period will also be able to apply for student admission quotas from abroad.

The applications of candidates;

- a) Turkish citizens who completed their entire secondary education in Turkey or the TRNC,
- b) Citizens of TRNC (except those who meet the conditions in Article 9, paragraph 1/e),
- c) dual nationals by birth defined in Article 9, paragraph 1/b,
- d) dual nationals by nationality (except those who meet the conditions in Article 9, paragraph 1/e),
- e) Turkish citizens who studied at schools affiliated with the Grand Embassies in Turkey and foreign high schools in Turkey or dual nationals whose first nationality is Turkish by birth defined in Article 9, paragraph 1/b, will not be accepted.
- f) Citizens of TRNC, those who have renounced their Turkish citizenship/Blue Card holders and foreign nationals who registered to secondary education institutions in Türkiye during the academic year (excluding embassy schools, international private educational institutions included in the MOBIS system and foreign nationals in our country within the scope of the project carried out by the Ministry of National Education) will be able to enter higher education institutions only with the Higher Education Institutions Exam (YKS).

The evaluation and placement of applications to Ege University, based on the TR YÖS and GCE AL exam results, are carried out by the EÜ YÖS Commission. Information regarding registered students is reported to the Council of Higher Education.

Quotas for students to be accepted from abroad for our university's associate and undergraduate degree programs,

1. As of the application date, candidates who have received 200 or more points in the TR YÖS exam held in the last year can apply to our University programs. However, candidates who will choose the Faculty of Medicine Program must have a score of 400 or more, candidates who will choose the Computer Engineering Program must have a score of 380 or more, candidates who will choose the Faculty of Dentistry, Pharmacy and Faculty of Letters/Psychology Program must have a score of 340 or more, candidates who will choose the Faculty of Health Sciences/Physiotherapy and Rehabilitation, Nutrition and Dietetics Program and Faculty of Engineering/Electrical and Electronics Engineering, Bioengineering, Mechanical Engineering, Civil Engineering Program must have a score of 320 or more, and candidates who will choose the Faculty of Engineering/Chemical Engineering Program must have a score of 300 or more. Otherwise, the preferences made for the programs mentioned above will not be taken into consideration, and other preferences of the candidate who meet the conditions will be taken into consideration during placement.

2. Candidates who are Citizens of TRNC and reside in TRNC and have completed their secondary education in TRNC and have a GCE AL exam result, and whose Mathematics result is A\* (140 Points), and at least two of their Turkish, Physics, Chemistry or Biology results are A (120 Points) can apply.

#### - Requirements for Applications

In order to choose our university programs, they should follow the [www.oidb.ege.edu.tr](http://www.oidb.ege.edu.tr) web page. Program preferences are made online by candidates via the [www.oidb.ege.edu.tr](http://www.oidb.ege.edu.tr) web page. During the preference process, the candidate logs into the system with the candidate number and password (created during the application) and fills out the preference form and selects the programs they will prefer. Placements are made within the framework of previously announced quotas based on a 20% country threshold on a program basis. According to Article 20 of the Ege University Directive on the Principles of Accepting Students from Abroad; "TR YÖS and GCE AL scores converted to the TR-YÖS point system of candidates who make their preferences in accordance with the conditions specified in the directive and guide are ranked from the highest score to the lowest score. The quota/country quota number of the program with the highest score in the ranking is placed in our university programs.

In case of equality in placement scores, the placement process is carried out by giving priority to;

- a) The candidate who is younger,
- b) The one whose order of preference is first,
- c) The one with the higher secondary school success score.

Those who score 200 or above in the TR-YÖS exam can apply for programs that can be preferred with the Language score in the YKS guide (English Language and Literature, American Culture and Literature, German Language and Literature, Translation and Interpretation programs and Tourism Guiding, etc.). These candidates must also pass the Foreign Language Proficiency Exam held by our University. Candidates who have chosen programs that accept students with a special talent exam determined by ÖSYM (Faculty of Sports Sciences or State Turkish Music Conservatory programs) must have received a score of 200 or higher from the TR-YÖS exam in order to be able to take the special talent exam. The candidates in question must also follow the relevant Faculty/College special talent exam calendar for the special talent exam and apply to the relevant school in person. Placements are made by taking into account the Composite Talent Score for programs that accept students with special talent, and the candidate's score from the TR-YÖS exam for other programs.

Candidates are placed in only one program. If there are no applications for the quotas in any program or if the quotas are not filled, the quotas that are not filled and for which there are no applications will not be transferred to other program quotas.

For students who want to study in undergraduate and associate degree programs with their own means, NO EXAM RESULTS (such as Tawjihi, Al Shahada, Abitur, International Baccalaureat etc. and SAT, ACT) OTHER THAN TR-YÖS (GCE AL for TRNC nationals who completed high school in TRNC) WILL BE ACCEPTED in the placements to be made to our University.

## ***2-THOSE WHO WILL STUDY WITH SCHOLARSHIP***

Candidates who are placed in a department at our University with a scholarship do not need to apply to our University. These candidates can only start their education by registering on the dates and in the manner announced on the [www.oidb.ege.edu.tr](http://www.oidb.ege.edu.tr) website.

## **REGISTRATION PROCEDURES**

Candidates placed in an associate or undergraduate program at our university will register on the dates and in the manner announced on the [www.oidb.ege.edu.tr](http://www.oidb.ege.edu.tr) website.

The documents required for registration are as follows;

1. Residence permit application form for those who do not have a valid residence permit (to be filled out on the [e-ikamet.goc.gov.tr](http://e-ikamet.goc.gov.tr) website) or valid student visa,
2. Originals of high school diploma and high school transcript,
3. Originals of Turkish translation of high school diploma and high school transcript approved by a notary in Turkey or a Turkish embassy,
4. For candidates with Turkish citizenship who completed their high school education abroad, an official letter from the school stating that they received face-to-face high school education, its Turkish translation approved by notaries in Turkey/Turkish embassies, and the originals of the barcoded document showing passport entries and exits obtained via e-government, (Those who graduated from high school in Turkey or TRNC do not need to obtain a high school equivalence certificate)
5. For candidates with Turkish citizenship who graduated from open education high schools abroad, a barcoded document showing passport entries and exits obtained via e-government, a foreign residence

document for the periods they studied, and the originals of their Turkish translations approved by a notary or Turkish embassy in Turkey,

6. The original of the High School Equivalence Certificate, (If the candidate is in Turkey; to be obtained from the Ministry of National Education or Provincial Directorates of National Education, if the candidate is outside Turkey; to be obtained from the Turkish Embassy/Consulate in the country where they are located)

7. Original Turkish translation of the passport approved by a notary or Turkish embassy in Turkey (Translation is not required for Turkish passports)

8. Photocopy of the pages of the passport showing the entry and exit stamps

9. Notarized photocopy of the residence permit/blue card/TC identity card/protection card

10. 2 photographs (photographs must be taken within the last six months, from the front, and in a way that can easily identify the candidate)

11. Original of the "Detailed Certificate of Birth Registration" document showing the date of transition to Turkish citizenship, which candidates who were foreign nationals by birth and later became citizens of the Republic of Turkey will obtain from the Population Directorates,

12. Originals of the Registration Forms with wet signatures,

13. For candidates who will study on their own means and are placed with a GCE AL score, GCE AL Result document and its Turkish translation (for candidates who apply as citizens of TRNC), TR YÖS exam result document for candidates who apply with TR YÖS,

14. If you have your Turkish C1 or C2 document (candidates who are Turkish/TRNC high school graduates will be exempt from Turkish),

15. Entitlement Certificate obtained from the Social Security Center (can be downloaded from [www.turkiye.gov.tr](http://www.turkiye.gov.tr) website)

16. All candidates to be registered in the Maritime Transportation and Management Program of Urla Maritime Vocational School are required to; -Be citizens of the Republic of Turkey, -Meet the legal conditions regarding Registration and Acceptance in Educational Institutions, Health Conditions of the Seafarers and Pilots Regulation and the Seafarers and Pilots Education and Examination Directive, -Have the "Seafarer Eligible Health Report" they have obtained in accordance with the procedures and principles determined in the Seafarers Health Directive published by the General Directorate of Borders and Coasts Health approved by the Health Inspection Center and obtain a Seafarer Health Examination Certificate. All candidates to be registered in the Underwater Technology Program of Urla Maritime Vocational School are required to; -Get an underwater man eligibility health report from state hospitals that have an underwater doctor or from private health institutions (Hyperbaric Oxygen Treatment Centers) that have an underwater doctor.

17. Candidates who will be registered to the Civil Air Transportation Management and Aircraft Technology program of the Aviation Vocational School; 1) Not have any criminal record or criminal archive record that would prevent them from obtaining an airport entry card. 2) Obtain a board report from a fully equipped hospital within the last 6 months stating that they do not have any health problems that would prevent them from performing the profession and/or the duties assigned to them (hearing loss/deficiency, vision loss/deficiency, etc.). \*Turkish Translations; Must be approved by a Notary in Turkey and by the Foreign Representatives of Turkey abroad.
